


# AAC GROUP

- Different communication styles and modes of communication
- Advocating for sensory and emotional needs.
- Communicative for a range of functions and purposes, including to:
  - Share information
  - Ask questions
  - Make comments
- Skills for interaction including:
  - Starting and ending conversations
  - Conversation topics
  - Managing miscommunications
- Understanding and using 'core vocabulary'
- Navigating social interactions with peers
- Understanding operational and interaction skills unique to AAC (e.g. finding new vocabulary)
