
STORY SPROUTS ORAL NARRATIVE

ABOUT THIS GROUP

This group aims to use the principles of the the **Supporting Knowledge in Language and Literacy (SKILL) Program** to teach the macrostructure and microstructure required to produce coherent oral narratives. There is a strong link between oral narratives and written expression and many children who cannot produce written texts struggle with oral narratives. The group will look at both the macrostructure of stories (e.g. sequencing, including characters, settings) and microstructure elements (e.g. vocabulary). This group uses visuals to teach each element of an oral narrative in a fun, engaging group setting. Participants are encouraged to share their ideas with their peers.
